- Train participants to process, repair, and price inventory to be sold in the retail setting
- Evaluate and assess participant knowledge and aptitude of basic hand tools and general trade skills
- Utilized provided curriculum to provide introductory trade skill learning opportunity
- Assist in program documentation

Additional responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Assist with retail, front desk, and customer service as part of a team
- Assist with donated and sold merchandise
- Facility maintenance

- Experience working with youth, young adults, and/or people with barriers to employment.
